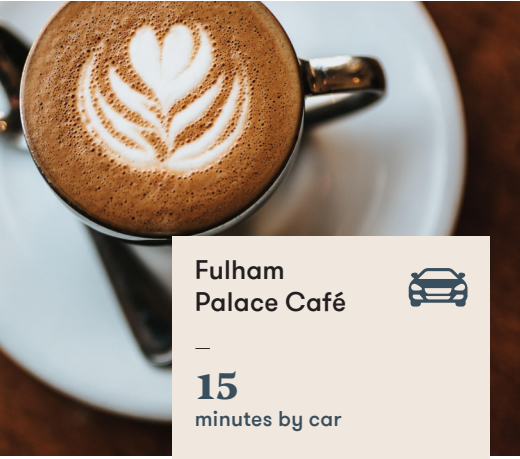

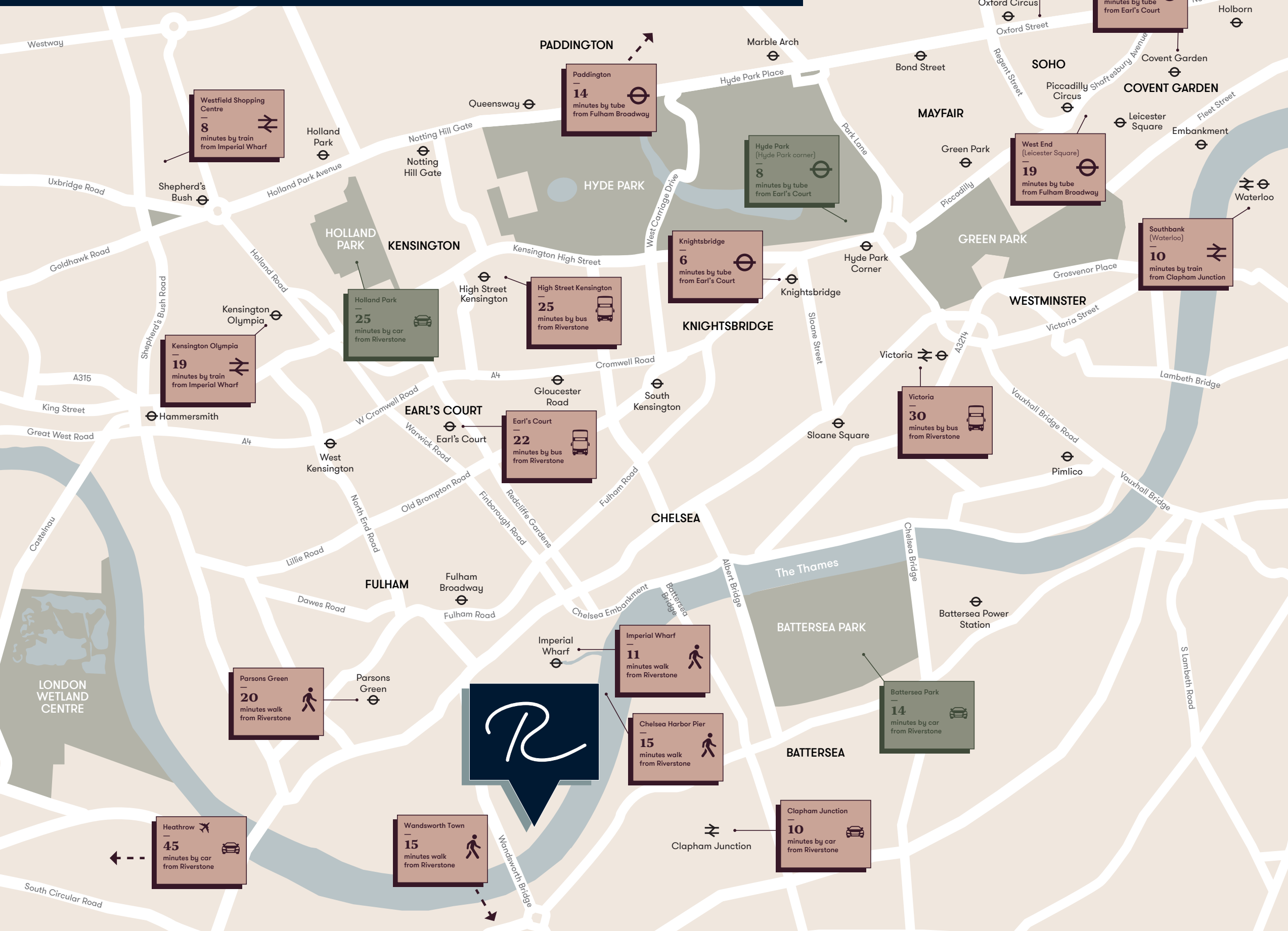

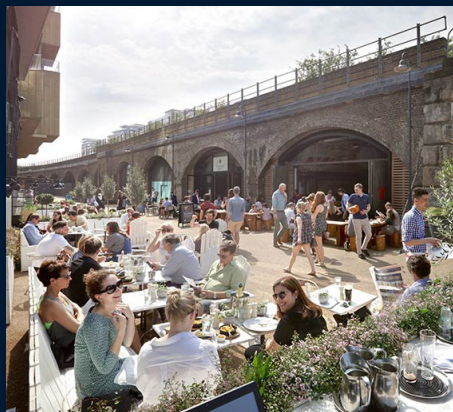

A legendary London landmark

Now brought back to life, the iconic Grade II* listed Battersea Power Station is one of London's most exciting shopping and leisure destinations. A place to enjoy a unique blend of shops, bars, restaurants, leisure and entertainment venues, parks and historic spaces.



The regeneration extends far beyond the brick walls. What was once 42 acres of industrial brownfield has been transformed into a vibrant new live, work and play neighbourhood.



A wide range of culinary delights is available, with restaurants specialising in an array of cuisines.

A truly mixed-use building housed in the historic turbine halls, c.2000 capacity event venue, a 18,500 sq ft food hall; a glass chimney lift and hundreds of new shops and homes.

A central atrium is topped with a glass and steel skylight and surrounded by three tiers of shops.

Easily accessed by car or by the new Zone 1 Underground station on the Northern Line.
