

# A world-leading cultural destination

Olympia London is undergoing a fabulous makeover with over £1.3 billion of investment. Due to open in 2025, this will be a destination for culture, creativity and entertainment and set to attract 12 million visitors each year.





Originally built in 1886 and known as the National Agricultural Hall, Olympia Exhibition Centre hosts more than 220 exhibitions and events each year, including the 'Olympia Horse Show' and 'Stylist Live'.



The site of the former Earls Court Exhibition Centre will be transformed with the addition of a live music venue, performing arts theatre, cinema, restaurants and bars. 4,400-capacity live music venue

1,575-seat theatre – the largest new permanent theatre build of its kind to open in London since the National Theatre in 1976
